Jack Petchey Funding – provision agreed activities, as requested by pupils and staff receiving awards.

**VRU PRU Mentoring Programme 2022-2024** – resilience mentoring, mentoring for girls and young women. Workshops, creative arts, school and holiday activities, parental support and involvement.
