- Croydon has the second largest working age - that's people aged between 16 to 64- population of the London boroughs
- It has the largest population of under 15 year olds in London
- 205,500 people are in work. That is above the national average rate of employment.
- Around 1 in 10 people in work are self-employed
- There are around 14,195 businesses in Croydon.

60 % of people in Croydon work in six sectors

- Health - 16,000 people in health and social care
- Retail - 16,000 people in retail - that's 13% of the total employment
- Education - 13,000 in education and training
- Professional, scientific and technical - 11,000 in engineering design, R&D, legal work etc
- Public administration and defence - 11,000 in national and local gov incl. fire and police
- Business administration and support - 10,000 in supporting businesses - employment services, equipment rental, security, buildings facilities etc.
