# Introduction

Funded by the Department for Education, the Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) programme provides free holiday club spaces for children in receipt of benefits-related free school meals during the Easter, Summer and Christmas school holidays.

With the increased costs of food and childcare, school holidays can be a challenging time for some families. The aim of the programme is to ensure children have access to a safe space in the holidays, where they can participate in exciting activities as well as have access to a nutritious free meal.

**Open to eligible children and young people living or going to school in Croydon, our holiday programmes will offer:**

- **free, nutritious and tasty food every day**
- **fun daily physical activity sessions**
- **a wide range of exciting activities to suit different ages, personalities and abilities**
- **opportunities to learn more about healthy eating and nutrition**
- **opportunities for children and young people to socialise with their peers and make new friends**

## HAF Easter Programme

The HAF Programme returns during the Easter 2026 holidays, where children and young people will be given an opportunity to attend free holiday clubs in their local area. At each club, children will be provided with a nutritious meal every day and get the opportunity to take part in exciting activities and games.

This Easter, we are proud to have a variety of clubs delivering a range of activities, from football camps, coding workshops, music-making camps, multi-sport clubs, plus many more. There are also opportunities for children to learn more about healthy eating and take part in cooking and preparing food.

All holiday clubs will cater for children with low-medium levels of SEN and/or disability, with a specialist SEN provision specifically catering for children with medium/high levels of special educational needs by offering dedicated 1 to 1 support. We would encourage you to contact the club directly on how best they can support your child.

## HOW TO BOOK?

Children in receipt of benefits-related free school meals at their Croydon school are entitled to up to 4 spaces at clubs this Easter. Each child will receive a unique voucher code to book their spaces. Voucher codes are allocated by schools and sent by HolidayActivities.

Whilst this document gives an overview of the clubs running this Easter, more information about the club and the activities they will be offering can be found on the HolidayActivities booking website.

### Follow the steps below to book a space

- 1. Look out for an email from HolidayActivities (hello@holidayactivities.com) stating 'You have been issued a voucher'**
- 2. Register/Login to claim your unique voucher code**
- 3. Book up to 4 days/sessions at a holiday club**



# SUPPORT

Children in London primary schools now receive free school meals for the 2023/24 academic year, also known as universal free school meals.

In order to be eligible for the HAF Programme, you must be in receipt of benefits-related free school meals. If you believe you are eligible for benefits-related free school meals, contact your school who can support you in applying for this to ensure your child can attend the HAF Programme.

If your child is in receipt of benefits-related free school meals but you haven't received a voucher code, please contact your child's Croydon school. Double check your child's details with the school, such as whether they are on the benefits-related free school meal list and/or whether your email address on the school system is correct. Schools will be able to support in allocating a voucher to your child.
